Courage for Crouton



Hi – my name is Crouton, arguably the most adored cat that ever lived. In fact, if love had the power to save, I'd live a thousand lifetimes. Let me start at the beginning... My mom is the most incredible, loving, courageous, devoted person I've ever met. One day I got really sick and could barely breathe – I was so scared. Without a second thought, my mom rushed me

to Osage Animal Hospital where they ran a bunch of tests to find out what was wrong with me. The news wasn't good – my chest cavity was full of chyle, a milky fluid produced in the

small intestines during digestion. I had multiple X-Rays, bloodwork, I.V.s and even a chest tube. I was in the fight of my life and my mom was fighting right



alongside me. She kept up with the medical expenses until she was down to her last dime, but I was in critical condition and wouldn't survive without the care I was receiving at the hospital. Mom refused to give up – she started a Facebook fundraiser and reached out to Caring Hearts to help cover the cost of the increasing medical expenses.

I couldn't believe how hard she fought for me. Her strength filled me with courage and hope. A few days later I started to feel better and finally got to go home! A couple weeks after that I went in for a checkup and doc confirmed my chest cavity was full of chyle again. I was worn out – as hard as I tried my little body just wasn't strong enough to keep fighting. I didn't know how much longer I'd have the strength to continue pulling air into my lungs. Mom could see it in my eyes – I was so tired. I tried to say, "It's okay mama, don't be sad..." The last thing I remember is being cradled in her loving hands – she was crying. Next thing I knew I was running across the rainbow bridge where everything was beautiful! I wasn't in pain anymore and had boundless energy to run and play.

I check in on my mom from time to time and am happy to tell you she is still helping other kitties who need a champion to fight for them. She is such a beautiful example of what humanity is supposed be; and although my life was cut short, I am so incredibly thankful for every day I got to spend just being her little Crouton.

Don't Let the Fur Fool Ya'

As we brace for another cold winter, remember our furry friends get cold too. Caring Hearts is committed to keeping pets safe and warm during the winter months. Even with outdoor shelter, if inadequate to protect against the cold, pets can still freeze. We can assist with straw or indoor crates so pets can be brought indoors. Here are a few helpful tips to help keep your furry loves ones safe and warm this winter:

- Use pet booties to minimize contact with painful salt crystals, poisonous anti-freeze and chemical ice-melt agents
- Change water bowls often to make sure clean water is accessible at all times
- Don't let the fur fool you – if it's too cold for you, it's too cold for them
- If you see an animal in need, say something; pets can and do freeze to death when left outside in extreme weather.
